Overview

MyNetball Learning is Netball's learning management system. It records learning that has been undertaken by netball participants as well as offering online courses and assessments. MyNetball Learning is part of MyNetball and requires participants to have a MyNetball login.

This guide steps through activities that you will need to undertake when interacting with MyNetball Learning. It covers common questions such as:

Course Enrolment

The online Foundation Coach Accreditation Course is targeted primarily at beginner coaches, teachers, parents and NetSetGO coaches and outlines introductory coaching information and basic netball techniques. The Course is the first step in the national coaching accreditation framework and is an important step along the knowledge pathway for a coach.
- Pre-requisites**
There are no pre-requisites to complete the online Foundation Coach Accreditation course.
- Enrolment Rules e.g. age restrictions**
Participants must be at least 14 years of age to access the accreditation.
- Enrolment process**
The Foundation Coach Accreditation Course is an online course that is accessible all year.
The Foundation Coach Accreditation Course costs participants \$50 to enrol.
In 2016, learners can access the Foundation Coach Accreditation course either online or through a face-to-face workshop delivered by their state or territory netball association. Successful completion of either course will result in the awarding of the Foundation Coach Accreditation.

Course Launch




