In 2022 Netball SA introduced the inaugural First Nations Framework, a strategic document designed to assist in actively contributing to increased participation rates and development of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander netballers in South Australia.

With the success of multiple initiatives from the Framework, Netball SA will continue building on this momentum with releasing the 2024 First Nations Framework.

This document will outline how Netball SA will continue with existing clinics, programs, and business strategies, in addition to how the business will continue to learn and develop new initiatives to prioritise the development of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander athletes in the game of netball.

- Continue to raise awareness of South Australia's high performance Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander athlete development and participation through the Rising Sisters Aboriginal Netball Program, Adelaide Thunderbirds Academy, The Hospital Research Foundation Group Premier League, State Teams, Adelaide Thunderbirds Futures & the Adelaide Thunderbirds.
- Raise awareness of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander athlete development and inclusive club cultures at the elite level through the Suncorp Super Netball First Nations Round.
- Keep South Australian netball's connection to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community top of mind.
- Melp grow the Netball SA staff connection to our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander
