The 2025/26 City Night Division Netball Competition **Survey Results Summary**


On 5 May 2025, Netball SA (NSA) in partnership with the Office for Recreation Sport and Racing (ORSR) released a survey to the South Australian netball community seeking feedback on some proposed scheduling changes for the upcoming City Night Division (CND) season due to upgrade works to the SA Netball Centre in Mile End.


The survey received an incredible 1,299 responses from players, parents and other stakeholders. NSA and ORSR would like to thank the netball community for taking the time to have your say.

Amongst other things, the survey presented two key scheduling options for respondents to consider:

- Option 1 to reschedule the CND competition to the South Australian United Church Netball Association (SAUCNA) Netball Facility at Park 22 (ANZAC Highway) for games to be played on a weekend. The proposed schedule under this option is to have juniors play on a Saturday morning and Seniors play on a Sunday Night
- Option 2 to reschedule the CND competition to a greater-metropolitan netball facility and play games on










We also sought information from respondents on the importance of different scheduling options:
