

Netball SA is proud to offer the 2026 First Nations Participation Scholarship!

The scholarship is designed to assist participants by way of a monetary subsidy to offset the costs of participating in netball as a player, umpire or coach. The monetary scholarship is administered by Netball SA, eligibility for the scholarship includes:

- Applicants must identify as being of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent
- Applicants must be registered as a current member of a Netball SA affiliated club or association
- Applicants must be aged 21 years or younger, for those under 18 years of age the application must be completed and consented by a parent or guardian

The scholarship can assist with but is not limited to:

- Supporting new or ongoing participation in an organized Netball SA affiliated competition
- Supporting opportunities to nominate for pre-elite level pathway competitions and teams
- Supporting opportunities to develop and upskill for umpire and coaching workshops
- Uniform requirements
- Travel fees

Applications will open on Monday 23 February, 9.00am and close on Monday 30 March, 5.00pm. Selection of successful applicants will be determined by a Netball SA Committee.

All applicants will be contacted the week commencing 6 April with confirmation of your application status.
