Netball SA's (NSA) Adelaide Metropolitan Netball Division (AMND) will commence on Fridays and Saturdays for the 2026 Winter Season.

- **Sub Junior (1-6) and Junior (1-6)** divisions will take place on Friday evenings at the Mile End Sports Complex outdoor courts at 155 Railway Terrace, Mile End SA 5031.
- **All remaining divisions** (including Sub Junior 7-8 and Junior 7-8) will take place on Saturdays at the Mile End Sports Complex outdoor courts at 155 Railway Terrace, Mile End SA 5031.
- **AMND League** will take place on Saturdays at Adelaide Arena (formerly the Adelaide 36ers Stadium/Titanium Arena) at 44a Crittenden Road, Findon SA 5023.

TICKETING

Entry Ticketing

In partnership with the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing (ORSR), ticket prices have been reduced to support accessibility while the competition is delivered across multiple venues during ongoing stadium works.

For the 2026 season, one (1) ticket per round gives access to the full weekend of Friday and Saturday AMND games at both Mile End Sports Complex (outdoor courts) and Adelaide Arena.

***All tickets in 2026 must be purchased online.** There will be no box office ticket sales available on game days, so make sure you secure your tickets before arriving.

Tickets for the Finals Series will be sold separately and become available at a later date.

Conditions of Entry

Persons who refuse to comply with conditions of entry will not be permitted to remain within the (Venue) and may receive further sanctions.

BALL ALLOCATIONS

All clubs will be allocated one (1) ball per team for the 2026 AMND season. Further details regarding the collection process will be provided later in the season once all stock has been received by Netball SA.

ADELAIDE ARENA KEY INFORMATION

Bathroom Location

Bathrooms for spectators and club officials are located on the left-hand side of the concourse upon entering the building.

Players, coaches, and officials may use the bathrooms located under the grandstands while actively participating in a game or warm-up. At all other times, including before and after games, they are required to use the bathrooms on the concourse level.

Please note that there are no change room facilities available at this venue. All players, coaches, and officials are required to arrive in the appropriate attire ready for participation.

Duty Room Location

In place of a designated duty room, a courtside table will be located on the blue concrete area to function as a central duty location. A Netball SA Court Supervisor/Duty Manager will be positioned at this location to distribute scoresheets and address any queries.

As AMND League is the only grade scheduled to play matches at Adelaide Arena, the High Performance and/or TID Umpire Panel will be present onsite for umpire supervision purposes.

First Aid Room Location

The first aid room is located along the right-hand corridor under the grandstand when facing the Western entrance. Clear signage is displayed in the hallway to assist with locating the room.

All players and key personnel are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the location of the first aid room upon their first visit to the venue.

Parking

On arrival, please follow the driveway until you reach the left turn, where parking is available on the grassed area opposite the stadium.

Please note that guests are not permitted to park in any space with “Pelligra” labels.

Pedestrian Entry and Exit

All players, officials, and spectators must enter and exit the stadium via the Western Doors, located on the left-hand side when approaching the car park. Please be advised that **access to the courts is via stairs only**; lift access and other accessible entry options are not available at this venue.

Spectators may use any available seating in the surrounding grandstands. Access to court-side areas for spectators is strictly prohibited at all times.

MILE END SPORTS COMPLEX KEY INFORMATION

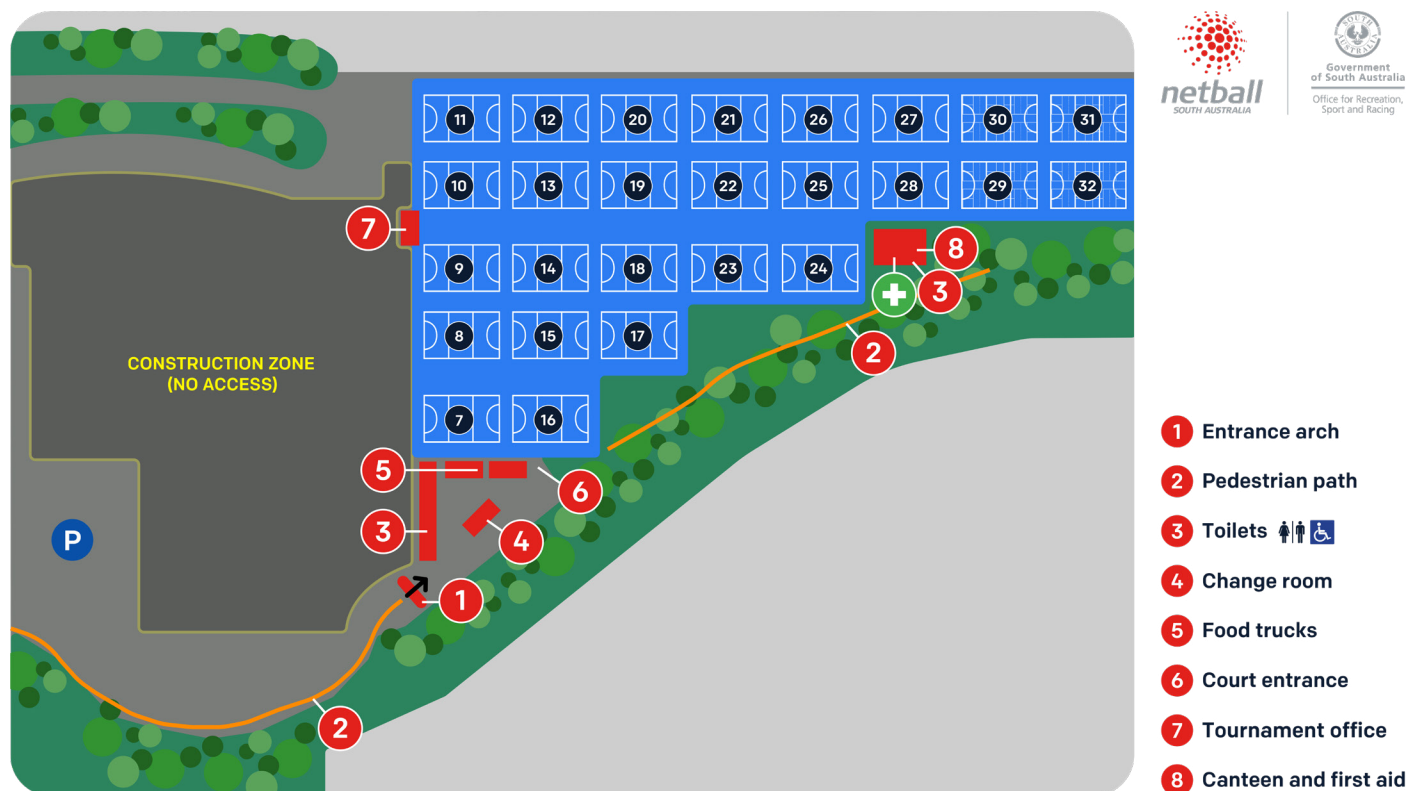
Bathroom and Mud Room Location

Two (2) toilet blocks, including accessible facilities, are available on site. These are located at the entrance near Court 7 and adjacent to the canteen near Court 24.

Private change rooms are not available. A designated unisex mud room (No. 4 on the site map) is provided for players to change footwear only. This space must not be used as a change room or gathering area at any time during the season. All teams, players, and officials are required to arrive dressed and ready to participate in netball activities.

Please note that the mud room is also the designated area for Wakefield Sports strapping services. Clubs should not rely on this space for any other purpose.

Tournament Office Location

The Tournament Office will be located between Courts 9 and 10 (No. 7 on the site map) and will serve as the central point for all competition-related enquiries and equipment access during match days. Club and team representatives may attend the Tournament Office to collect and return official scoresheets prior to and at the conclusion of play.

In addition, a ball pump will be available for use to ensure match balls are maintained at the appropriate standard. Please ensure that team representatives are familiar with the relevant ball pump regulations.

For matters requiring attention during the round, the Court Supervisor can be contacted via the Tournament Office or 0477 006 772.

First Aid Room Location

In 2026, Wakefield Sports will provide strapping services in the Change Room, where players and officials are required to attend for all strapping requirements. The Change Room is located near Court 7.

For all other First Aid requirements, players, officials and spectators must attend the designated First Aid Room, located near Court 24 (No. 8 on the site map). **On-site Contact Number: 0477 006 772**

Food and Beverage

A range of food and beverage options will be available for purchase from food trucks located at the court entrance near Court 7 (No. 5 on the site map) and at the canteen near Court 24 (No. 5 and 8 on the site map).

Please note that this is a **cashless venue**. All food and beverage purchases must be made using EFTPOS facilities.

Parking Plan

Due to the redevelopment, ORSR has mandated a 40–60 minute interval between games to accommodate reduced parking capacity and ensure safe traffic flow.

Accordingly, Netball SA requests that spectators, officials, and families do not arrive earlier than **30 minutes** prior to their scheduled match, to allow the car park to clear. At the conclusion of each match, all participants, officials, and spectators are expected to depart promptly and refrain from gathering to support the efficient movement of traffic.

For the final timeslot each day, all attendees must vacate the venue promptly, as Netball SA is required to fully clear the outdoor courts shortly after the final match concludes.

Pedestrian Entry and Exit

All spectators, players, and officials must enter the venue via the Entrance Arch (No. 1 on the site map). All attendees are required to scan in using a pre-purchased online ticket upon entry.

QR codes will be available at the entrance to facilitate online ticket purchases; however, **no box office or on-site ticket sales** will be available at any time during the season. Please note that attendees are not required to scan out when exiting the venue.

Access to the courts is via No. 6 on the site map. No matches will be scheduled on this court, ensuring a clear and accessible entry and exit pathway for all attendees.

REMINDERS

Coaching and Umpiring

Netball SA would like to remind all Clubs of the importance of maintaining accurate and up-to-date records within PlayHQ. All coaches and umpires must be listed on the platform to ensure they are appropriately covered for insurance purposes while participating in the AMND Competition.

In addition, clubs are responsible for ensuring that all coaches and umpires hold a current Working with Children Check (WWCC) where required. It is essential that verification of these clearances is completed, and that all relevant documentation is kept up to date, securely stored, and readily accessible if requested.

Finals Umpires

Additionally, Netball SA would like to remind clubs that it is a requirement to provide one (1) umpire for every one (1) Team that qualifies for the Finals Series.

Clubs are encouraged to regularly review and plan their umpiring capacity throughout the season to ensure this obligation can be met. Where needed, clubs should proactively engage with Netball SA to access development opportunities, education, and support to upskill their umpires well in advance of the Finals Series.

TID Umpire Squad

For the 2026 AMND season, the TID Squad will assume responsibility for umpiring and supervising all AMND League matches. Additionally, the Development Squad will oversee and officiate a portion of Inter 1 matches. To support coverage across the full schedule, Clubs will be required to nominate an umpire for Inter 1 matches. Further information on this nomination process will be distributed shortly.

Single Game Vouchers

In accordance with the Netball SA Single Game Voucher (SGV) process, all players completing an SGV via PlayHQ are required to pay the \$10.00 fee at the time of registration. All SGVs must be registered and paid online via PlayHQ [here](#).

If a Club elects to cover the cost of an SGV, any reimbursement must be arranged directly by the Club. For further details, please refer to the Conditions of Play or Single Game Voucher Process.
